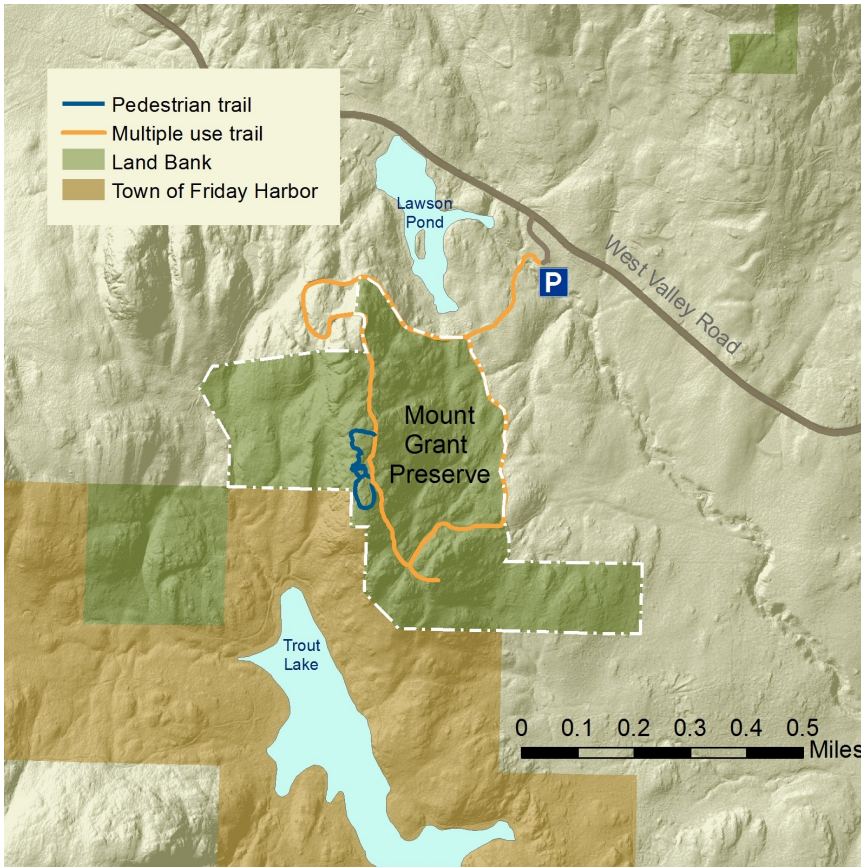


MOUNT GRANT PRESERVE

Directions

From the Friday Harbor Courthouse
(mileage approximate):

- 0.0 Turn right on Guard St.
- 2.75 Guard Street becomes Beaverton Valley Rd.
- 3.9 Beaverton Valley Rd. becomes West Valley Rd. at intersection with Boyce Rd.
- 4.9 Turn left and look for Mount Grant parking on the left.

When you visit:

- Pedestrians, bicycles, and horses remain on designated roads and trails.
- No fires or camping.
- Dogs must be leashed.
- No hunting.
- Take nothing
- Leave nothing.
- **Starting summer 2015, driving access to the ridgetop will be available on designated days.**

Fundraising is underway to permanently conserve Mount Grant's 141 acres for the public. Once the Campaign to Save Mount Grant is successfully completed, community input will guide the creation of a management plan, trail development, and other preserve activities.
