

# BEAVERTON MARSH PRESERVE

## San Juan Island



### Directions

#### Roche Harbor Rd Access Point:


##### From the Friday Harbor ferry landing:

Turn left onto Spring Street.  
At 0.1 miles, turn right onto Second Street.  
At 0.4 miles turn right onto Tucker Avenue.  
At 1.4 miles road name changes to Roche Harbor Road. At 2.3 miles arrive at Beaverton Marsh Preserve on the left. Parking exists for about 10 cars and is open to public use after haying has occurred, usually June or July.

#### Beaverton Valley Rd Access Point:

##### From the Friday Harbor ferry landing:

Turn left onto Spring Street.  
At 0.1 miles, turn right onto Second Street.  
At 0.3 miles Second Street becomes Guard Street. At 1.1 miles Guard Street becomes Beaverton Valley Road. At 2 miles arrive at parking area. Parallel parking exists for 1-2 vehicles at roadside pullout. Open year round.

**When you visit:**

- Pedestrian, equestrian and day use only at northern access; pedestrian and day use only at southern access

Located northwest of the town of Friday Harbor, the Land Bank's 477-acre **Beaverton Marsh Preserve** protects a vital and expansive wetland system, rich agricultural lands, scenic views and essential wildlife habitat. The sloping hillside accessible from Roche Harbor Road is open for daytime pedestrian and equestrian use after summer haying has occurred, most often late June or early July, and ends when the field becomes saturated by fall rains, usually in mid-October. The southern public access to the preserve, located off of Beaverton Valley Road, is open to pedestrians for day use year-round. A short path leads visitors to an overlook that provides a fantastic opportunity to watch for winter waterfowl.
