Bulk Seed

The Salish Seeds Project produces seed native to San Juan County grasslands, oak savannahs, and meadows. A selection of seeds is available for purchase by San Juan County residents, landowners, and land conservation partners. There are two ways to purchase seeds:

1. We offer a small selection of pre-made seed packets which come with sowing and growing instructions. Click “Seed Packets” on the Salish Seeds Project website for more information. In addition, we often sell packets of local, native wildflower meadow mix during our annual Fall Native Wildflower Sale.
2. We also offer bulk seed for sale. Bulk seed is weighed out and packaged up to order and does not come with instructions, making it most suitable for restoration professionals and experienced growers. The minimum purchase quantity per species is 20 grams. An additional \$5 per species processing fee is applied to each purchase to cover processing and packaging. Bulk seed orders may be picked up at the Land Bank’s office at 328 Caines Street in Friday Harbor. To place a bulk seed order, contact Eliza Habegger at the San Juan County Land Bank (elizah@sjclandbank.org; 360-370-7653) with a list of species and quantities desired. Please allow for up to 2 weeks for us to package your order.
